The OIG received an allegation that a Providence Maintenance of Way Base employee was smoking marijuana during his shift. The allegation was referred to Amtrak's Drug and Alcohol Programs Manager for investigation. The employee subsequently tested positive for marijuana and Rule G was implemented placing the employee into treatment under the guidelines of the Employee Assistance Program.
