



SUPERVISOR TERMINATED FOR TIME AND ATTENDANCE FRAUD

Web Summary: OIG-WS-2018-324

An Amtrak Track Supervisor in Hasbrouck Heights, New Jersey, was terminated from employment following an administrative hearing on May 24, 2018, for theft related to time and attendance fraud. Our investigation found that, from March to April 2016, the employee wrongfully claimed at least 30 hours of regular scheduled time and overtime hours. In addition, on January 22, 2017, he submitted 14 hours of regular time and another 14 hours of overtime for the same day. In total, we determined that the supervisor caused Amtrak to pay him over \$1,700 for time not worked.
