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**AMTRAK EMPLOYEE ABUSES VEHICLE PRIVILEGES AND  
TIME AND ATTENDANCE**

**APRIL 25, 2013**

Our investigation disclosed that an employee who worked in a prominent leadership position of significant trust was found to have abused his Amtrak vehicle privileges and engaged in substantial time and attendance abuse. We determined that this employee regularly worked as a high school football coach and trainer during claimed paid hours. Our investigation found that the employee left work early on many days to attend football practice or games while he was supposed to be on duty at Amtrak. He also often used an Amtrak vehicle to drive to his coaching activities, for which he received other compensation. The employee was often unavailable to his Amtrak subordinates, who attempted to contact him for operational direction. He voluntarily resigned when confronted with the results of our investigation.
