Theft of GSA Fuel Credit Cards

A source reported that several GSA fuel credit cards were stolen from Amtrak property and were being used to make unauthorized fuel purchases. Surveillance of the gas stations where fuel purchases were being made with the stolen credit cards, revealed that the cards were being used by an associate of a former Amtrak Mechanic. The individual was arrested. The individual pled guilty to one count of Theft of Government Property and was sentenced to six months home confinement, three years probation, and was ordered to make restitution to Amtrak in the amount of \$57,424.
