



Lead Service Attendant Sentenced

The Office of Inspector General (OIG), Office of Investigations (OI), recently learned that a former Amtrak Lead Service Attendant (LSA) who was the subject of an OI investigation was sentenced to 1 year's probation and time served (67) days. She was also ordered to pay fines, costs, and fees.

After being indicted and charged with one count of theft/deception and one count of theft/unauthorized control of more than \$300 and less than \$10,000, the LSA failed to appear for her initial hearing in 2006. An outstanding bench warrant resulted in her arrest and subsequent sentencing.
